

## Summary of the due-diligence policy

### Teknik Innovation Norden Fonder AB ("the company")

The company has adopted a due-diligence policy where the company describes how the company considers negative consequences for sustainability factors in its investment decisions.

The company has decided to consider negative consequences for sustainability factors, which means that the company, when making investment decisions, takes the following into account: environmental, social and employee matters, respect for human rights, anti-corruption and anti-bribery matters. The company has identified relevant areas where negative consequences for sustainability factors may occur and describes in its policy how the company prioritizes between different negative consequences. The company considers negative consequences for sustainability and states in its policy what measures the company takes to ensure that negative consequences for sustainability is included in the investment decisions. In this process, the company e.g. uses a select in/select out method and follows international codes of conduct for responsible business such as the UN Principles for Responsible Investment, the UN Global Compact and the OECD's guidelines for multinational companies.
